


## SSAR: Self-Reported Student Academic Record


- Required INSTEAD of a transcript for certain universities
- Must match EXACTLY!
- Report ALL grades taken for high school credit (including high school credits earned in middle school)

## **Entering Coursework:**



- We operate on <u>semesters</u>
- Class Level for College Academy courses: Dual Enrollment
- Use Academic History drop down menu in Virtual Counselor for history of your grades
- List all classes taken for HIGH SCHOOL CREDIT (including high school credits earned in middle school)
- Some classes will have two 0.5 credits → list each grade earned for each semester
- For a class in which you earned 1.0 high school credit → enter a grade (the same grade) for BOTH semesters
- For a class in which you earned only .5 credit (ex. SLS1501) → list the class and grade in the semester you took it
  - Leave the other "semester" box empty
- Summer term should be listed in your JUNIOR YEAR
- BC Science labs do NOT count for high school credit → do not list on SSAR

## Sending it to universities:

 Each university will have instructions on their admissions page or portal on how to link your SSAR with your application to that school
