

# College Application Guide 4 steps

#### 1. Online application

- Includes essay, extracurricular activities/resume, etc.
- Create an account, you can save and return to complete it (in most cases)
  - College or university's website
  - Common App (UF, FSU, UCF, NSU, UM) http://www.commonapp.org/
  - Coalition App <a href="http://www.coalitionforcollegeaccess.org/">http://www.coalitionforcollegeaccess.org/</a>

## 2. Send OFFICIAL SAT and/or ACT scores (if school is not test-optional this year)

- These must be sent directly from your CollegeBoard and ACT accounts
  - o Costs: SAT \$12/ACT \$13 per report, per school

## 3. <u>Send High School Academic Record: Transcript OR SSAR</u>

## **Transcript**

- If applying in CommonApp or Coalition, NO REQUEST NEEDED!
- If applying directly to institution -> Request transcripts Naviance
  - →Allow several school days to be sent. It will be sent directly from high school to the university
  - → Follow up with the UNIVERSITY to check that they received it (online portal or call admissions office)

## SSAR (Self-Reported Student Academic Record)

- Create an account online (FREE) at <a href="www.selfreportedtranscript.com">www.selfreportedtranscript.com</a>
- Student enters grades for each class taken in high school
- ALL GRADES MUST MATCH EXACTLY
- Use "academic history" in Virtual Counselor as a guide
  - o FSU, UF, FAU, FLPOLY, UNF, FGCU

## 4. Payment

- State colleges and universities: ~\$30-35 each
- Private/out of state schools: ~\$70+ each
- FEE WAIVERS: If you are eligible for fee waivers for the SAT/ACT, you have application fee waivers for college applications in your CollegeBoard account online and additional waivers are available in the BRACE/School Counseling office
- Scan & email fee waiver to university admissions office
